



WINNICA TURNAU WINO X CZERWONE

WINE DESCRIPTION

A red wine from the 2022 vintage, crafted from a blend of select red grape varieties. On the nose, intense cherry aromas intertwine with subtle barrel notes of toasted wood. The palate reveals juicy cherry and sour cherry flavors, accented by a gentle sweetness and a hint of white pepper. An excellent companion to Italian cuisine or grilled meats.

GRAPE VARIETIES

VINIFICATION

12-day maceration on the skins. Aged for 18 months in barrique-type Slavonian oak barrels, used once or twice before.

TERROIR

Winnica Turnau is located in Baniewice, in the southwestern part of the West Pomeranian Voivodeship. This unique region is influenced by air masses from the Atlantic Ocean and the Baltic Sea, as well as the proximity of the Oder River. All these factors shape a climate characterized by a long growing season, warm summers, and mild winters. Such conditions favor the cultivation of demanding grape varieties, allowing them to reach optimal ripeness while maintaining high acidity. Our region is distinguished by a rich network of oxbow lakes, gently rolling moraine hills, and an abundance of flora and fauna. The vineyard is situated on a moraine hill, where the predominant soils are sandy-clay, clay, moderately compact, and moderately permeable. This terroir, combined with ecological viticulture, results in grapes of exceptionally high quality.

WEATHER DURING THE GROWING PERIOD

The winter of 2021/2022 was snowy with a lot of frosty days. Early spring did not have a lot of precipitation and the entire spring was rather dry, but this did not delay the growing season. There were no spring frosts. The summer was warm but also rainy. The autumn was dry, with moderate temperatures. With the long ripening of the latest varieties, the harvest lasted quite a long time.
